

## FAQs

*Q. What kind of worship service can I expect?*

A. The worship service will feature music and liturgy (Rite II) with Holy Eucharist, all in the rich tradition of the Episcopal Church.

*Q. How long will the worship service last?*

A. About an hour.

*Q. What if I'm not Episcopalian?*

A. **Everyone** is invited to join us! And all baptized Christians are welcome to receive communion.

*Q. Can you tell me more about Sunday School?*

A. There will be children & youth classes this Sunday, one for our God's Growers children's group – which is ages 4 and under, one for our God's Builders children's group – which is ages 5 to 9, and one for our exciting and action-packed youth Sunday school for ages 10 & up that will meet in the upper gym. Soon, we will start Sunday School for adults.

*Q. Can you tell me about various programs at St. Benedict's?*

A. We already have established several fellowship groups for our members, both children and adults. There is the Women's Group, the Men's Group, a Youth Group for older children and teens, and God's Growers and God's Builders groups for younger children. We also are committed to putting Christ's ideals into action, so we have formed partnerships with several community organizations, such as MUST Ministries and Good Samaritan Health Center of Cobb.

*Q. Can you tell me more about the choir and your music program?*

A. Music and singing will be an integral part of worship at St. Benedict's, and we recently appointed a very experienced organist and choirmaster (Leslie Boyette) to lead our music efforts. Our new choir will perform during our first worship service on January 13, so join us and find out for yourself! We also will be forming a children's choir soon.

*Q. Will it be contemporary music?*

A. No, our Sunday morning service will feature organ music from our 1982 Hymnal, our alternative hymnal "Wonder, Love, and Praise", and other Episcopal sources. However, we do plan to launch a Saturday or Sunday evening service that will feature contemporary music and other instruments.

*Q. What about the breakfast this Sunday?*

A. It will be a full breakfast! We know how it is hard to get kids dressed and going in the morning, so this will make it fun for them and also easier on the parents.

*Q. Can you tell me more about the nursery?*

A. We have secured exclusive space at Campbell for the nursery (we're the only ones with access to it), and we have fully outfitted for use as a nursery. It will be staffed on Sunday mornings by experienced, trained childcare professionals.
